

Trail of the Eagles' Nests

I really like castles. During the summer holidays I went on a trip to the castle in Bobolice and Mirów with my parents. These castles belong to the Trail of the Eagles' Nests. These were built in the 14th century by King Casimir the Great. There is a proverb about the king: "Zastal Polskę drewnianą, a zostawil murowaną" (When he ascended Poland was wooden, when he left us, it was from stone) - he had raised many castles during his reign. They formed the defensive line of Poland. It goes from Częstochowa to Kraków. The castles are built on white limestone rocks. From each castle you can see two neighboring castles, which made it possible to be informed about the incoming enemies.
