






The wadden sea

The Wadden Sea is the inland sea between the Wadden Islands and the North Sea on the one hand, and the mainland of the Netherlands, Germany and Denmark on the other. The area stretches between Den Helder in the Netherlands and Esbjerg in Denmark, has a length of 500 km and an average width of 20 km.










Het drie landen punt






The port of Rotterdam

The port of Rotterdam is the largest port and industrial complex in Europe with a total cargo throughput of 470 million tons in 2019. It consists of a combination of various port basins and industrial sites that serve the supply and removal of goods from the (petro)chemical and other industries located at the ports, and the storage and transhipment of goods from third parties for further transport. Rotterdam was the largest port in the world between 1962 and 2004, but this position has been taken over by Shanghai. Singapore, Canton, Qingdao, Port Hedland and Tianjin have also surpassed Rotterdam as a port in size. However, Rotterdam is still by far the largest European port.






The Zaanse Schans

The Zaanse Schans is a unique village in the Netherlands, full of wooden houses, mills, barns and workshops.






The Veluwe

Kinderdijk






Linden tree

The Linde van Sambeek is a very old, sizeable Dutch lime (Tilia x europaea) that stands along the main road in the south of the North Brabant.






The Delta works






the Rijksmuseum

The Amsterdam canals


Amsterdam is the wateriest city in the world.

The oldest canals in Amsterdam are called the wallen.






The Binnenhof




THE CHEESMARKETS



There are about 30 large and 25 small forts in the New Dutch Waterline. Also 5

fortified towns and castle fortresses Loevestein and Muiderslot are part of the

New Dutch Waterline. During the First World War and just before the Second

World War I there are about 700 reinforced concrete group shelters and 80 machine gun casemates built. There are also 95 locksThe Old and New Dutch Waterline is actually one and the same waterline. It

The big difference is that the New Dutch Waterline is located more to the east of the Netherlands

and that the important garrison city of Utrecht lies within the line.
