

A GREAT EUROPEAN SNAIL QUIZ – A BOARD GAME

RULES

AIM of the game:

To learn interesting facts about the European Union and Europe in general.

PLAYERS:

The game is intended for 1-5 players or 1-5 teams of players. One student or the teacher plays the part of the game leader and holds the answer key.

THE GAME SET:

The game set consists of:

- a snail board with explanations
- pieces
- dice
- task cards

HOW TO PLAY:

Each player or team of players chooses a piece. The piece is moved over the board after completing each task.

- The player (team) moves the piece forward after rolling the dice. The space on which the piece lands has a number. The number of the space is the number of the task card. The task cards are located in different places around the classroom and need to be found by the player (team).
- The player (team) finds the task card and reads the question.
- The player (team) thinks of an answer and comes back to the game leader to give the answer to their question.
- If the answer is correct, the player (team) roll the dice, move the piece to the space indicated by the number on the dice and goes on to solve the task designated for this particular space.
- If the answer is not correct, the player (team) moves back two spaces.
- There are a number of special fields on the board, each type in a different colour.

- ⑨ The green space – roll the dice again
- ⑨ The yellow space – move three spaces back
- ⑨ The yellow space – go back to the start
- ⑨ The brown space – move back to space number 2
- ⑨ The purple space – miss a turn
- ⑨ The blue space – move to the Sirius space and solve a surprise task (hidden in a QR code).

- The first player (team) to reach the FINISH space wins the game.

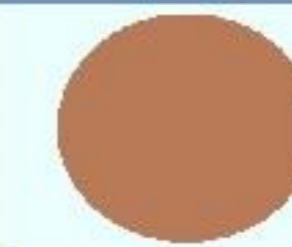

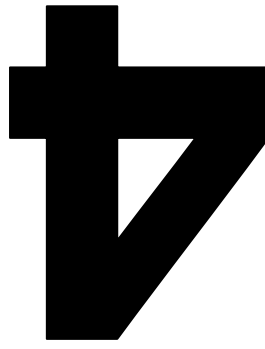

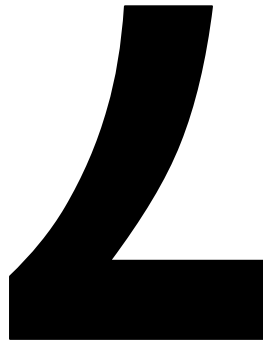
